Privacy policy

Introduction

We are Lions Gate International (UK) Limited ("**LG UK**", "**us**", "**our**" or "**we**"). We provide the website located at http://www.lionsgatefilms.co.uk/ (the "**Site**").

This policy explains how and why we use personal data (also known as personal information, personally identifiable information or PII) for the purposes of providing, promoting and developing the Site. This policy also provides contact details and important information about privacy rights.

We explain the Site in more detail in the Terms of Use. Please read this policy together with our Terms of Use http://www.lionsgatefilms.co.uk/terms-of-use.

What personal data do we collect?

We collect personal data relating to website visitors when they interact with the Site. This is information about you that you give us by filling in forms on our Site or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. It includes information you provide when you register to use our Site, search for a product, enter a competition, promotion or survey, complete a job application form and when you report a problem with our Site.

Specifically, we collect the following types of personal data relating to Site visitors and other individuals –

- a) Name and address.
- b) Date of birth.
- c) Contact details (including email address and phone number).
- d) Payment details (in limited circumstances).
- e) Registration for any contests, features and other promotions offered as part of, or in relation to, the Site.
- f) Participation in online research.

- g) Reports of issues with the Site.
- h) Correspondence (including email and chat).
- i) Screen names.
- j) Submissions, voting and polling activities.
- k) Site usage and activity.
- I) Search queries.
- m) Information about interests.
- n) Technology used to access the Site, including -
 - Device information.
 - Browser information.
 - Internet service provider or mobile carrier.
 - Referring and exit pages.
 - Date and time stamps.
 - Clickstream data (including page clicks and scrolls).
 - Location.
 - Bandwidth speed.
 - Software and registry keys.
 - IP address and device ID.
 - Information from cookies and similar technologies.

In addition to collecting personal data directly from Site visitors, we collect information from social media companies as well as other companies with whom Site visitors and other individuals have a relationship ("Partners"). Partners include Internet Service Providers, third parties that support the Site, online and offline data providers and voice assistant platform providers. We recommend that Site visitors and other individuals read the privacy policies of all organisations that process personal data relating to them.

How we use personal data

We use personal data of the categories listed above to provide, promote and develop the Site. More specifically we use personal data to –

- Improve the Site by providing personalised content, language, help and instructions.
- Customise the Site by location.
- Provide customer service assistance.
- Ask Site visitors to participate in surveys, products, services, news and events.
- Provide Site visitors with news, newsletters, updates, targeted advertising, promotions, and special offers.
- Better understand how Site visitors use the Site (including checking traffic patterns and what types of content are most popular).
- Receive and respond to submissions or correspondence.
- Use Site visitor submissions in accordance with the Terms of Use http://www.lionsgatefilms.co.uk/terms-of-use for the Site.

- Administer community postings (for example, chat and bulletin boards), including publishing screen names and other information provided by Site visitors on the Internet or elsewhere.
- Repost comments about the Site, programmes and/or content on various online platforms and social media (for example, on X, formerly Twitter).
- Check email engagement (e.g. whether you open emails).
- Exercise and comply with legal rights.

Our legal grounds to use personal data

Necessary for the performance of a contract

Where we use personal data to provide the Site to visitors or to otherwise perform our obligations and exercise our rights under the Terms of Use http://www.lionsgatefilms.co.uk/terms-of-use our legal ground is primarily that doing so is necessary for the performance of a contract with the Site visitor.

Legitimate interests

Where we use personal data relating to individuals with whom we do not have a contract for the purposes of the Site, our legal ground is that doing so is necessary for the legitimate interest of operating and progressing our business.

Similarly, where we use personal data relating to Site visitors outside the Terms of Use http://www.lionsgatefilms.co.uk/terms-of-use for the purposes of the Site (for example, the development and promotion of the service), our legal ground is that doing so is necessary for the legitimate interest of providing, developing and promoting our business.

Where we send Site visitors emails (or other electronic messages) containing promotional material about the Site, our legal ground is that doing so is for necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interest of promoting our business.

Sometimes, we may use personal data if necessary for a third party's legitimate interest. Where required and appropriate, we or the third party will provide you with more information about any such legitimate interest.

We will also use personal data where we have a legitimate interest in establishing, exercising or defending our legal rights.

Importantly, we will not use personal data on the grounds of a legitimate interest where the relevant individual or Site visitor's rights and freedoms override the legitimate interest. In addition, where we rely on a legitimate interest to use personal data, the individual or Site visitor to whom the personal data relates may object. To object please contact us at privacy@lionsgate.com. This right to object does not apply where our interests are so compelling as to override your interests.

Consent

If we need consent to use personal data (for example, for advertising cookies), we will request consent in a clear manner and explain for what purpose the personal data will be used.

Legal obligations

Separately from providing, developing and promoting the Site, we will also use personal information when we are required to do so by law. Where that is the case, our legal ground is that the use of personal data is necessary to comply with a legal obligation.

Automated decision-making

We may use automated decision-making to provide Site visitors with the most relevant content and develop the Site. However, we do not use automated decision-making to make any legally significant decisions about individuals.

Sharing personal data

Social media

Site visitors and other individuals may engage with the Site through third-party social networks (for example, Facebook, Twitter and Pinterest). We may also allow Site visitors to access their accounts or specific content through social networks. Where Site visitors or other individuals engage or login through social media, we will share personal data with and receive personal data from the relevant social network. Where Site visitors or individuals engage or login through a social network, we recommend they read the relevant social network's privacy policy.

Partners

We share personal data with and receive personal data from Partners.

Service providers

To help provide, develop and promote the Site, we share personal data with and receive personal data from the following types of service provider –

- Payment processors.
- Advertising partners.
- Analytics service providers.
- IT providers.
- Professional services (for example, accountants and lawyers).

We have contracts in place with these service providers that strictly govern how they may use the personal data (listed above) we share with them.

Group companies and business reorganisations

We will share personal data (listed above) with our group companies where necessary to provide, develop or promote the Site.

We will share personal data with potential buyers, group companies and/or business partners where necessary for a reorganisation, restructuring, merger, sale or transfer of assets involving us and/or the Site.

Legal rights and obligations

We will share personal data where necessary to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights.

We will also share personal data where required by the courts, regulators or law.

Cookies and similar technologies

Cookies

Cookies and similar technologies are small information files that we place on the devices used to access the Site. They include embedded scripts, web beacons, and other similar technologies. The types of Cookies we use are described below:

We use Google Analytics to analyse the usage of our website. This analytics service generates statistical information about our website use by means of cookies used to help us improve performance, security and user experience. Some of these analytics and optimisation tools may be classified as low-risk and may not require prior consent, however, you can opt out of them at any time using the cookie controls provided.

We, and selected third-party advertising partners, use cookies and similar technologies to present adverts through the Site.

We have **not** implemented a response to browser-based Do Not Track signals.

Analytics

We, and selected analytics service providers, use cookies and similar technologies to provide analytical information about how the Site is used, and to help us detect issues or improve performance. This may include cookies used for site optimisation and usage reporting. We will either seek your consent for these cookies or provide you with an opportunity to opt-out.

Consent

Where we need to seek consent for analytics, advertising and other non-essential cookies and technologies, we will ask for it via the cookie banner when you visit the Site.

Cookie Management

You can use the methods described below to manage Cookies. You must take such steps on each browser or device that you use. If you replace, change or upgrade your browser or device, or delete your cookies, you may need to use these opt-out tools again. To exercise choice regarding cookies and tracking technologies:

- Browser Controls: You may be able to disable and manage some Cookies through your browser settings. If you use multiple browsers on the same device, you will need to manage your settings for each browser.
- Analytics Provider Opt-Outs: To disable analytics Cookies you can use the browser controls discussed above or, for some of our providers (e.g. Google, Apple), you can use their individual opt-out mechanisms

We routinely transfer personal data to other countries, including to the United States. In some cases, we may also rely on other legally recognised mechanisms, such as transfers to countries or territories that have been formally assessed as providing an adequate or equivalent level of protection. Data retention

We keep personal data relating a Site visitor for up to seven years after we last interacted with them.

Rights

- **Erasure** of personal data.
- Portability of personal data.
- Withdraw consent where our use of personal data is based on consent.
- Rectification of personal data.
- Restriction of personal data.

Please be aware that these rights are not absolute and there may be some situations in which they cannot be exercised or they are not relevant.
