

# Let's Make It StoryBots Pencil Holder



Have fun making  
all your StoryBot

Put a drop of glue at the top and bottom of the can and wrap the can with yarn. Use glue as needed to hold the yarn in place.

## Supplies

Green Yarn,  
Green Craft Foam,  
Tall Tin Can,  
2 Bottle Caps,  
Orange Pipe Cleaners,  
2 Googly Eyes,  
Scissors, Glue

Ask an adult to help you cut.

Add a drop of glue on the back of each googly eye and place each eye inside a bottle cap.

3



Place a drop of glue on the back of the bottle caps, then place the two bottle caps at the top of the can.

4



Cut two strips of craft foam to make eyebrows and glue each eyebrow (at a slanted angle) to the bottle caps.

5



Put a drop of glue on the back of the can. Wrap the pipe cleaner around the can, bending the front ends to make arms.

you ought to do...




Wear flowers, and you'll be **OKAY**.


