

A DINO-SIZED MISSION KIT

DINO ISLAND: THE FLOOR IS LAVA

The volcano is rumbling on **Dino Island**, and the Pups need your help to make it safely to the beach! Kids will come together as a team to cross the “**lava**” and complete their mission with **confidence**.

SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- Plastic river stones, carpet squares, foam tiles, or pieces of paper
- Tape or signs to mark the starting point, “**The Volcano**”
- Tape or signs to mark the ending point, “**The Beach**”
- **Optional:** Dinosaur footprints, PAW Patrol character images, or lava-themed decorations
- **Optional:** Cones or floor markers to create different path challenges

DIRECTIONS

1. Select an open space where kids can jump freely. Mark one end of the space as “**The Volcano**” and the other as “**The Beach**.”
2. Create a place where kids can pick up a number of “**rocks**” for different group sizes to start the game. Each group should have one rock for each player, plus one extra rock. A kid playing solo can use two rocks.
3. Invite kids to start at the volcano and use the rocks to create a safe path across the lava. **Players may only step on the rocks**, not the lava! To move forward, children take turns picking up the rock behind them and placing it ahead of the group. If one player “falls in,” have the team start again at the volcano and talk about what to do differently this time.
