



## Friendship Garden Design Competition

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

1. The pupil competition is open from the 14<sup>th</sup> February 2022 to children/pupils at schools that have registered for *Cartoon Network Adventure Academy* education programme. Entrants must be aged 5-11 years and live within England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland. All entrants must get permission from their parent/guardian and their school for entry, as evidenced on the entry form.
2. No purchase necessary.
3. The Promoter shall collect, store and use the personal information of the Promotion's participants in strict compliance with all applicable laws and regulations governing same for the purposes of contacting the winning entries only.
4. Only one entry per pupil (one education establishment may submit multiple entries).
5. The winning competition entry will be selected by our education team, based on successfully fulfilling the following criteria:
  - a) Each *Friendship Garden Design* entry must be created and completed by a child and not a parent or guardian.
  - b) Pupils/children can use additional or mixed medium to colour in or decorate their *Friendship Garden Design*.
  - c) In addition to their design, pupils must clearly write three design features for the *We Bare Bear* characters and humans.
  - d) Their *Friendship Garden Design* must be original.
  - e) Once all the above criteria have been met, the winners will be selected based on originality and effort.
6. To be eligible for this competition, pupils must submit their entries by post or email (see entry details at the bottom) by 6pm on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022. The Promoter (the Promoter and Organiser) and Organiser reserve the right to revise this date and extend the period for accepting competition entries in the event of circumstances arising beyond reasonable control.
7. The winning child/school will be notified by a representative from SUPER. via email and/or telephone within 30 days from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022. The winners will have 6 months to claim their prize (unless Covid Government restriction cause a delay), at which point, the organiser reserves the right to pick another winner.
8. The winning child will receive the following prizes:
