Art and Design Task:

Create AN AMAZING POSTER that reflects an HONEST self-assessment of yourself.

The poster should illustrate what you consider to be your main QUALITIES as well as any SHORTCOMINGS you have.

Here's some ideas about what you could put into the poster:

- ★ What you're good at.
- ★ What you most enjoy doing.
- ★ Your best school subjects.
- ★ Your greatest quality.
- ★ The tasks/subjects/jobs you find easiest to do.
- ★ Your greatest *Teen Titans Go!* strength.

And also:

- ★ What you think you could improve.
- ★ Personal targets.
- ★ A timeframe for achieving the target.

Tasks/subjects/jobs that you find difficult:

If you wish, your completed poster can be submitted as your *Teen Titans Go!* competition entry – ask your teacher for an entry form.

Writing Task:

Write a short article called 'What I'll be doing in 2035'. Remember, you'll be (approximately) 26 year's old. You can use the same criteria (above) to help structure your writing although you can write your piece in whichever way you prefer.
